From the medieval walled city of Dubrovnik to the dramatic beauty of Kotor Bay, Dalmatia is surely one of the loveliest parts of Europe.

You will also visit remarkable monuments created by classical civilisations including Butrint in Albania and the Roman Palace of Diocletian in Split. Crossing the Adriatic Sea you'll reach Ravenna, famous for its early Christian mosaics in the Church of San Vitale and 5<sup>th</sup>-century Mausoleum of Galla Placidia.

The cruise concludes with a hotel stay in one of the most beautiful cities in the world: Venice.
